General guidelines for IIIT Allahabad Students on Medical Treatments

All IIIT Allahabad student beneficiaries should note as follows:

- 1) w.e.f. 20/8/2025, medicines prescribed by the Institute On-Duty Medical Officers are issued on CASHLESS BASIS from the Institute Pharmacy shop located in the Institute Shopping Complex Area. Basic Lifesaving essential medicines for night time or other situations are only stored at the IHC Registration Desk to meet emergency situations and NOT for routine dispensing. All stakeholders are ESSENTIALLY required to CARRY THEIR INSTITUTE ISSUED ID Cards for consultations as well as receiving medicines on CASHLESS Basis from Institute Pharmacy Shop.  - 2) Kindly note the Doctors' timings at Institute Health Center as per the circulated and displayed schedule and plan your visits for consultations accordingly.
 - 3) In case STUDENTS are referred for OPD Consultations to Higher Centres / Specialists look for the ones already empanelled by the Institute. In Cases requiring Hospitalization, upon the advice of the Institute On-Duty Medical Officer, look for NETWORK Hospitals of the Insurance Company PROVIDING CASHLESS FACILITY TO STUDENTS. List is available on the link: <https://www.iiita.ac.in> > Health Center > 2.8) List of Network Hospitals at Prayagraj under MCAIP OR 2.9) List of Network Hospitals outside Prayagraj under MCAIP, as the case may be.
- (Imp-(1) The MCAIP Policy is renewed every year from the office of the Dean (SA). Students are advised to check the inclusion of their names in the insurance policy coverage from the same office. (2) Students are free to choose any hospital (For IPD) of their choice from list at 2.8 and any specialists (for OPD) of their choice from the list at 2.9 above, once the Institute Medical Officer advises for higher consultation)
- 4) For CASHLESS Pathological Diagnostic Tests, Institute has an MOU with Lal Path Labs, who collect the samples from Institute Pathology Room (8am to 2pm on working days) and provide the reports directly on the registered phone number of the patient. The facility is available to all Bonafide Students, Faculty, Officers, Staff members and the declared and registered Dependents. Retired Employees and their dependents can avail this facility on Cash payment basis only, BUT at applicable CGHS Rates for tests listed in CGHS Rate List and rest on 20% discount on MRP. All stakeholders have ESSENTIALLY to produce their valid Institute issued ID Card for availing the services.
 - 5) For Imagings like Xray, CT, MRI etc, Institute has an MOU with Kriti Scanning Centre, Nr MLN Medical College, who entertain the Institute students, Faculty, Officers, Staff Members, Retirees and the dependents on Cash Payment basis at their counter, BUT ON CGHS Rates and on production of valid Institute issued ID Card ONLY.
