The Secretary Senate welcomed all the members present in the 23rd meeting of the Senate. Chairman Senate welcomed all the members and gave a brief introduction of newly co-opted external members, Prof. Ganesh Ramakrishnan, IIT Bombay and Dr. Santanu Dasgupta, Senior Vice President Reliance, Mumbai who were attending very first meeting of the Institute's Senate. Chairman Senate also gave a thankful message and best wishes to Prof. K. Chindananda Gowda Ex-VC, Kuvempu University and Prof. A. G. Ramkrishnan, IISc Bangalore for one more term as a member of Senate of IIIT-Allahabad. It was also resolved to place on record the contributing services rendered by Prof. Rajiv Tripathi, MNNIT-Allahabad, Dr. Sumit Ganguli, IIT Kanpur, Prof. Shekhar Mazumdar MNIT-Bangalore and Prof. K. Sethupathi, IIT-Madras.

Then Prof. P. Nagabhushan, Chairman Senate and Director, IIIT-Allahabad shared with all the Senate members that he has submitted his papers through the Chairman of BoG to the Secretary/Additional Secretary of MoE seeking relief from the post of Director sooner by three months by 18th February 2022 in place of 18th May 2022 due to his new assignment as Vice Chancellor of Vignan's Foundation, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh. AGENDA ITEM NO. 23.03

To review the proposed Restructuring/Reformatting and Modalities pertaining to M.Tech Program

Prof. Shekhar Verma, Dean (A&R) presented the Agenda. He apprised about the needs for Restructuring/Reformatting and Modalities pertaining to M.Tech Program, structural changes in program instill the spirit of NEP in the PG programs, financial Support and Admission Criteria of the different departments.

Most of the members including external members of the Senate contributed their opinions. A lot of deliberations were held and the proposal was received in principle. The Chairman Senate then recommended formation of a Senate Sub-Committee including external members Prof. A.G. Ramakrishnan, Prof. Ganesh Ramakrishnan and Dr. Santanu Dasgupta. The above Sub-committee would look into various aspects including all interdisciplinary M.Tech programs and M. Tech proposals from all the departments and come out with an exhaustive workable report considering all features including admission process, types of M.Tech, group wise admissions, administrative and legal aspects and other points discussed.

The Committee is expected to give its report as early as possible preferably in the first week of March' 2022 so that it can be implemented from the next academic session which will begin in July'2022. Prof. Manish Goswami and Registrar would take care of all important dates like intimation to CCMT etc.

The proposal was received very positively but for a workable implementation the above Senate Sub-committee had been formed and focus should be starting the M.Tech Course from the upcoming academic session.

It was informed by the HoD (AS) that in the list circulated with Agenda, two PhD students 1. Abhishek Muhuri (Sl.No.2) and 2. Neha Kumari (Sl. No. 7) withdrew their admission. Dean (A&R) and Associate Dean (R&D) presented the above Agenda Item. After that the matter was open for discussions. As per suggestion for Minimal degree requirements: publications, patents and ABDC Journals were also included. The members also sought few clarifications.
