❖ Name of Courses in Centre for Sanskrit Learning:

There will be two courses in these center's.

- **“Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language”.(8 Credits)**
- **“Diploma in Sanskrit Language”.(12 Credits)**

➤ NATURE OF COURSES:

- It is a credit based part-time course.
- The duration of the course will be from August, 2025 to May, 2026 for the academic session 2025-26.

COURSE OF STUDIES

➤ “Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language”.(8)

- Its objective is to develop the elementary skills of speaking, writing and reading day to day practical Sanskrit. Prathama Diksha (First Level) published by Central Sanskrit University will be taught in this Course. Under this, five books i.e., Varnamala (वर्णमाला) Vakya-vyavaharah (वाक्यव्यवहारः), Vakyavistararah (वाक्यविवस्तरः) Sambhashanam (सम्भाषणम्) and Parishishtam (परिशिष्टम्) are included. These five books will be taught in simple Sanskrit. A minimum period of 120 hours is required to complete the course.

The outcomes of the Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language:

- Study and practice of simple Sanskrit conversation.
- Proficiency in day-to-day Sanskrit conversation.
- Introduction to the basic structure of Sanskrit language.
- Familiarity with Sanskrit vocabulary and gradual build-up of new words in Sanskrit.
- Provision of pictorial study materials. (Prathama Deeksha)

❑ Eligibility for Admission:

- Anyone, above the age of fifteen, who is curious to learn Sanskrit is eligible to take admission in "**Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language**". The admission is open for all the students, teachers, employees and officers of the concerned institution and also family members and general public.

➤ **“Diploma in Sanskrit Language”.(12)**

- It aims at developing the skill of expressing in Sanskrit all those ideas which are important from practical point of view. First 5 Levels of Dvitiya Diksha (Second Level) published by Central Sanskrit University will be taught in this course. Sanskrit subhashitas, stories, different types of special exercises, simple Sanskrit grammar compiled in Vyavahara-pradeepah (व्यवहारप्रदीपः) will also be taught in this course. A minimum period of 150 hours is required for this course.

The outcomes of Diploma in Sanskrit Language:

- An introduction to the overall foundational structure for study of Sanskrit language.
- Gain mastery in using Sanskrit language.
- An introduction to advanced Sanskrit grammar.
- Engaging learning materials with shlokas, stories, essays, etc.
- Efficiency in self-study of Sanskrit granthas like Shreemad-bhagavadgeeta, Hitopadesha, Panchatantra, etc.

❑ Eligibility for Admission

- Only those who have passed the **First Course** i.e. "**Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language**" conducted by Central Sanskrit University will be eligible to take admission in the **Second Course** "**Diploma in Sanskrit Language**".

STUDY MATERIAL.

- Study material will be provided by Central Sanskrit University. This will include First and Second Level (प्रथमा दीक्षा एवं द्वितीया दीक्षा) books.

➤ Admission process:

The admission process will be done through Samarth portal. For this, learners have to register through this link <https://csucsl.samarth.edu.in>, after which they have to select the intended course and pay the fees of Rs. 1200/- through online portal.

Step 1 : Registration

Step 2 : Filling all the details of learner

Step 3 : Programme and Centre Selection

Step 4 : Documents uploading.

Step 5 : Fees payment and final submission.

➤ Examination

- ❑ In the session 2024-25 the examination will be conducted by Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi on May, 2025 through **online mode**. The marksheet and certificates will be distributed to the successful learners.
- ❑ Learners who are unsuccessful or absent in the examination may deposit the examination form along with the examination fee to appear in the next year's (2026-27) Annual Examination through online mode.
- ❑ The learners of the Centre for Sanskrit Learning will be given two chances to pass the examination in two consecutive years only, starting from the Academic year of enrolment, for example, the learner enrolled in the academic year 2024-25 will be entitled to appear in the Annual Examinations in 2025 or 2026 only.
