Dr. Jaideep Kumar Mishra, Joint Secretary , Meity, Prof. Abhay Karandikar, Director, IIT Kanpur and Prof. Archana Shukla Director IIM Lucknow could not attend the meeting due to their preoccupation and were granted Leave of Absence.

In addition to Sri Rakesh Ranjan Additional Secretary MoE being present, the comments of MoE on the Agenda Items were also conveyed by Sh. A.K. Chatopadhyay, Under Secretary IIITA vide his email dated 8.07.2021 just before the commencement of the meeting. These comments were placed by the Secretary BoG before the Board of Governors and the members to put on record and were duly considered during deliberations.

The Secretary BoG extended hearty welcome to all the members, who were present in online meeting. Hon'ble Chairman also extended his warm welcome to all members. Since this was the first meeting that Hon'ble Chairman was attending, Hon'ble Director introduced every member to Shri V.K. Modi. Subsequently the Hon'ble Director formally welcomed all the members and special invitees present at the meeting.

Before the formal commencement of discussion based on the listed agenda, Hon'ble Director shared the following:

1. There was a period of calamity in the campus during the second wave of Covid. About 72 people in the campus suffered the attack. This included 18 families and some students. Now the situation is under control and as on day the campus is corona free. However, unfortunately two staff members succumbed. This set back was one of the reason for delay in the conducting of the BoG meeting, which was initially proposed to be a month ago.
2. Our team has come out with the design of a Nanotechnology based Covid Test Kit , which is now undergoing an exhaustive validation test at the Medical Institute (KGMOU) Lucknow, before it is declared fit for technology transfer. Also Nanotechnology based design of sophisticated mask is in its final stage of completion. Apart of that our team produced sanitizers in house. Our

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team was also associated with the experimental validation of the Covid prediction Model designed and developed by Prof. Manindra Agarwal and team at IIT Kanpur.

3. Many research papers pertaining to Covid have been published and many research proposals around the Covid theme are submitted to the funding agencies. Some of them are already supported.
4. For the first time, IIIT Allahabad has entered into the book of QS world ranking. It has been positioned in the 1000th rank band. This amounts to the fact that IIIT Allahabad has been significantly positioned in top 30 group amongst QS ranked Indian Institutions. The Education World has placed the Institute in top 30 range. In the ranking by India Today, Institute is in 10th position among all Government technology institutions.
5. The upcoming convocation will be on 11th September 2021. Due to the impact of ongoing COVID, this convocation will be in e-mode. Dr. Devi Prasad Shetty, Padma Bhushan awardee, the Chairman of Narayana Hrudayalay will be the Chief Guest.
6. Despite of the pandemic acuteness, the academic term has been maintained very well in IIIT Allahabad and all teaching –learning –assessing activities have been happening as per schedule.

In the sequel, the Secretary BoG started with the agenda item;

18.01 To receive the Minutes of the Seventeenth Meeting of Board of Governors of the Institute held on 19.12.2020.

The minutes of the meeting were circulated to the members vide E-mail dated 23rd December 2020. Since no comment was received, the minutes were accordingly confirmed subsequent to circulation. The minutes of the seventeenth BoG uploaded in the institute website.

Resolution: The Board noted and received the minutes of Seventeenth meeting of BoG which were accordingly confirmed.

18.02 To review the Action Taken Report on the Minutes of Seventeenth Meeting of Board of Governors of the Institute held on 19.12.2020

The review of Action Taken Report on the Minutes of Seventeenth meeting of the Board of Governors of the Institute held on 19.12.2020 was taken up. It was mentioned that certain items were re-itemised viz; agenda no 18.07, 18.08, 18.12 and 18.14 and placed for discussion before the BoG.

Resolution: BoG noted the ATR.

18.03 To apprise the minutes of the 4th meeting of the Council of IIITs-Status of Action Taken thereon.

With permission of Chair, Prof. Vijayshri Tewari, Secretary BoG moved the agenda and provided opening remarks. The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 22.03.2021 has informed that 4th meeting of Council of IIITs was held on 16th October, 2019 and had asked for Action taken Report (ATR).

One of the important agenda contained there in, was an advisory note pertaining to the appointment of the Registrar, for which BoG's direction has been sought.

Technical Section comments of MoE :- Item No. 4.14:- As per the IIIT Act, 2014, IIIT Council is the Apex Body for taking policy decisions for IIITs(CFTIs). All the IIITs(CFTIs) are bound to follow the decision of the IIIT Council. In view of the decision taken by the IIIT Council in its 4th meeting, Institute may be advised to initiate process for appointment of regular Registrar immediately.

Item nos.4.17, 4.18, 4.20 and 4.23 of 4th IIIT Council meeting, BoG may take a view/decision for implementation of decisions of the Council in consultation with Senate, as the case may be. Action taken by the Institute in this regard may be intimated to the Ministry immediately, so that the same may be incorporated in the agenda of the next IIIT Council meeting.

Director IIITA conveyed to the BoG that the advertisement for the post of Registrar is under the process and will immediately be advertised after the 16th convocation which is scheduled on 11th September 2021. ASTE (MoE) also offered his comments as there was a never a full time Registrar and requested to advertise the position for regular Registrar. The House further observed that anyone eligible as per the norms and qualification applicable may be allowed to apply irrespective of him/her being an academician or otherwise.

Item nos.4.17, 4.18, 4.20 and 4.23 of 4th IIIT Council meeting may comply accordingly.

Resolution of BoG: Board approved that the advertisement for the post of full time Registrar could be released immediately after the convocation in September 2021, as per Recruitment and Promotion norms (RPN) for Non-Faculty, 2016. Anyone eligible as per RPN may apply.

- 18.04 To ratify the Selection Committee for the appointments made for Departments of IT & ECE held on 20/10/2020 and 21/10/2020.

With the permission of the chair Secretary BoG presented agenda regarding the selection process against the Advertisement Nos. FS-03/9th September 2019 (Special Recruitment Drive) for Assistant Professor (On Contract) was carried out for the Departments of IT and ECE

Comments of Technical Section, MoE : Names proposed in the above Agenda were approved by AS(TE) as Member of the Board and communicated vide letter dated 27.10.2020 (copy enclosed) and may be ratified. It may also be clarified why the names sent by the email dated 08.03.2021 and approved vide dated 16.03.2021 (copy enclosed) have not been brought before BoG for ratification.

Director IIIT had apprised members that under the agenda no.18.04 the selection of the Assistant Professors [special drive] was already conveyed to all BoG members by circulation. The due approval was accorded by the Chairman BoG. Hon'ble AS (TE), MoE had also communicated his endorsement vide Ministry's letter no F.No. 45-12/2016- TS.1 dated 16th March 2021.

The board was requested to provide its formal ratification for the details, which were already communicated to all the members.

Resolution: The BoG ratified the appointments (special drive) made for departments of IT and ECE .

18.04 [1] To ratify the appointments of Assistant Professors, Associate Professors at IIITA.

18.04 [2] To ratify the selection of Professors in the Department of IT & ECE, Applied Science and Management Studies in the meeting of the Selection Committee held on 19/03/2021.

18.05 To consider and approve the Implementation of the Roster (faculty roster position).

With the permission of Chair, Secretary BoG had presented the agenda regarding recommendations of the Selection Committees for the positions of Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors were Selection Committee Meetings conducted and Interviews held on April 10th, 11th & 12th, 2021 and on 19/03/2021.

Technical Comments MoE:

It has been mentioned in the agenda item that advt. No. Advt.No.FS-04/13th_Sep/2019 was for UR candidates only. However, after examining the same, it is found that there was no mention about it and the said advertisement was open for all the categories, The institute has placed this agenda for ratification whereas it should have been brought for approval.

This Ministry vide letter dated 18.11.2019 (copy enclosed) issued guidelines for implementation of the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in teachers' cadre) Act, 2019. It was also clarified that the reservation of posts in direct recruitment is to be done on the sanctioned strength in the teachers' cadre, regardless of the branch of study or faculty and who are remunerated at the same grade of pay (excluding any allowance or bonus) considering a Central Educational Institution as a unit. All the IIITs were requested to ensure that the rosters are made accordingly to the provisions mentioned in the aforesaid letter and the recruitment process is carried out accordingly within one month.

Further, as per Notification dated 12.07.2019 issued by this Ministry as referred in aforesaid letter dated 18.11.2019 inter-alia stipulates that- the Central Government hereby specifies that there shall be reservation of posts in direct recruitment out of the sanctioned strength in teachers' cadre in a Central Educational Institution in the manner specified in Office Memorandum, No. 36039/1/2019-Estt/(Res.) of DoPT, dated 31st January, 2019 to the extent as follows, namely:—

- (a) 15% for Scheduled Castes;*
- (b) 7 1/2 % for Scheduled Tribes;*
- (c) 27% for socially and educationally backward classes; and*
- (d) 10% for economically weaker sections*

It is not clear whether the Institute has followed the above guidelines while proceeding for appointment of posts of Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors. As per 4-Tier

Flexible Faculty Structure applicable in IIITs, for grant of Professor HAG Scale, the relevant experience should be six years as Professor with AGP of Rs.10,000/- or Rs.10,500/- (as per 6th CPC) in an Institute of National Importance.

Further in Item No.18.5, Institute has proposed for amendment in implementation of the Roster (Faculty roster position). Institute may strictly follow the above instructions issued by the Ministry for implementation of Roaster for faculty.

Institute may clarify the above positions before taking approval of the Board.

The suitable clarifications regarding the roster followed, vacancy matrix which was considered for the purpose and the legal opinion sought on the validity of the vacancy matrix and following of roster, before the commencement of interview process, were placed before the Hon'ble members. It was also placed before the house how the entire process of selection adhering strictly to the four-tier scheme was carried out. It was further brought out that all details were submitted to the Honorable Chairman of the BoG for his kind approval. Observing that the entire process was in order and was meticulously carried out, the house was requested to ratify the selections made.

Hon'ble members noted all the details and received the clarifications provided. The members went through the summary tables of the selected candidates.

Resolution of BoG: The BoG approved and ratified the appointments of the Assistant Professors, Associate Professors (level-10, level-11 and level-12) and Professors (level 14-A) subject to following the reservation roster as per Gol rules .

Concurrent to the agenda, it was also observed that against the approved 109 positions, 80 positions are filled up and the next advertisement for the remaining posts would be made after September 2021, so that the process of selection could be had towards the end of 2021. It was also explained how inspite of the repeated advertisements certain reserved positions like ST, EWS and PWD are not getting the applicants, and how those vacancies are getting blocked. It was also brought to the kind knowledge of the Hon'ble BoG that the request for additional 50 faculty positions is pending at the Ministry. The approval for the same and also the approval for the pending request pertaining to additional staff positions, were presented particularly to impress upon the Hon'ble representatives from the Ministry to which, the Hon'ble AS(TE) responded positively that his office would look into the matter and he advised that the institute could send the complete details again.

Hon'ble Chairman suggested that the Institute should follow up accordingly.

18.06 To apprise the case of Shri Gangadhara D. Junior Technical Superintendent (JTS) withdrawal of resignation as requested.

With the permission of the Chair, Dean (Human Affairs) presented the agenda and informed that the agenda was presented to apprise the BoG and the ground on which Shri Gangadhara has approached the Hon'ble Court for withdrawal of his resignation. Hon'ble Chairman clearly observed that the BoG cannot discuss the matter since the case is sub-judice in the court.

Technical comments of MoE: *As the matter is sub-judice in the Court of Law, accordingly, the same may be defended by the Institute as per the extant Rules.*

Resolution of BoG: BoG resolved as there is no stay order the Institute can advertise the vacant post and defend the case in the court of law.

Agenda item No.

18.07 NEP inspired new B.Tech program acronymed as BEST with the provision of multiple discipline and multiple exist and entries.

(ii) NEP inspired post B.Sc 3 year M.Tech program.

(iii) To consider and approve the ordinances, curriculum and other details of "NEP Inspired (Dual Degree) Program in Management –IT (IPM-IT)) at IIIT Allahabad.

With the permission of Chair, Director IIITA had discussed the agenda before the BoG members and elaborated the details given in the NEP Program and referred the annexure.

Technical comments from MoE : *During the 17th BoG of the IIIT Allahabad held on 19.12.2020, against the Agenda Items 17.6 and 17.8, the Board resolved the following:*

"A detailed report pertaining to the institutions of NEP inspired new programs would be sent to all members, and if members require that a presentation be made, then the concerned team could make such a presentation" Accordingly, a presentation with complete details was made by the Institute on 30.12.2020 vide Video Conferencing to the Board members. The Institute submitted a compliance report vide email dated 10.02.2021. After detailed examination, comments of AS(TE) as Member of the BoG were sent to Secretary to BoG, IIIT Allahabad vide email dated 25.02.2021 (copy enclosed) with a request to place a revised proposal before the BoG for consideration. The Institute may highlight the differences in the programmes (apart from numbers of intake).

Director IIITA apprised that IIIT Allahabad has come out with an ordinance to implement a B. Tech. program in Twin Streams of learning, comprising of theme stream of the institute (IT/ECE) and the other an allied stream (Applied Mathematics, Applied Physics, Biomedical Systems and Management Technology) for which the expertise is available at IIIT Allahabad as on date. He also presented that upon the conventional completion of 160 credits by the candidate, a candidate gets a B.Tech majoring in one stream and minoring in the other stream, while upon the extended completion of 200 credits with equal weightage of both the streams, the candidates gets B.Tech in twin stream. Prof. Prithish Varadwaj had also made a presentation where details of hostel accommodation with respect to availability of vacant rooms to accommodate students both in boys and girls hostels of IIITA were provided.

The discussion was getting stretched beyond the stipulated time. Observing this, the Hon'ble

Chairman BoG advised that a sub-committee of BoG may be constituted for taking the discussion to completion, and thereafter the recommendations could be approved by circulation.

Resolution: BoG resolved that as per advice of Chairman BoG it should be sub-committee consisting of Prof. Manindra Agrawal, IIT Kanpur, Prof. P. Nagabhushan, Director, IIIT-Allahabad and Prof Arvind Chaubey, Director, IIIT-Bhagalpur should be constituted to take the issue to convergence and provide recommendations for implementation of NEP based program, within a span of 15 days time.



Agenda item No.

18.08 To examine the appeal of Shri Abhishek Kumar Rai (Enroll No. IEC2018016) under section 37 of IIIT Act (sub clause(4)).

With the permission of Chairman BoG, Prof. Shekhar Verma, Dean (Human Affairs) presented the case and informed that the Sub Committee of the BoG has noted that the Senate has already taken a sympathetic view by revoking his dismissal (Rustification) to give him a chance to improve himself. Revocation of dismissal was with the view to reform the errors. The intent of the Senate is not retribution. Sub Committee in its recommendation concluded the following :-

- a) A joint Undertaking, by Mr. Abhishek Kumar Rai and his Parents, shall be required to be submitted to the Institute stating that if the student is again caught on the wrong end, he shall be summarily "Dismissed" from the Institute.
- b) After getting enrolled a fresh in B.Tech 4th Semester a fresh from 1st January, 2022 he shall be on a very strict disciplinary probation up to 7th Semester.

Technical comments from MoE : *BoG may take a view after detailed discussion.*

Resolution:- Hon'ble BoG has accepted the recommendation of the sub-committee for strict compliance.

18.09 To report the Annual Report and Annual Accounts of Institute F.Y 2019-2020.

The Secretary BoG presented the agenda and stated that the 35 copies of both the Annual Report and Annual Audited Account of Hindi and English version of the Institute for the Financial Year 2019-20 along with delay statement and review report submitted to MoE. The Board has been informed that Separate Audit Report (SAR) for IIIT-A for the year ended 31st March 2020 received from CAG, have no adverse audit observation and Institute account is regularly maintained as per the Govt. of India guidelines/rules.

Technical comments from MoE : *This Ministry has received the Annual Report and Annual Accounts for the F.Y. 2019-20 and the same will be laid in the both the Houses of the Parliament during the ensuing session. Status of Annual Report and Annual Accounts for 2020-21 may be given.*

Resolution of BoG:- Hon'ble BoG noted the Annual Accounts & Annual Report of IIIT Allahabad for the F.Y.2019-2020 submitted to the Ministry for laid down in both the house of Parliament and ratified the same.

18.10 To ratify the 21st meeting of the Senate held on 07/06/2021.

The 21st meeting of the Senate of the Institute was held on 07/06/2021. Minutes of Senate meeting unanimously approved and forwarded to members (on circulation) for their comments and observation, if any. The agenda is place before the Hon'ble BoG for ratification.

Technical Comments of MoE: *May be ratified as per extent rules.*

Resolution: BoG ratified the 21st minutes of the Senate Meeting.

18.11 Representation of Dr. Ashutosh Kumar Singh, Assistant Professor (Level-12), Deptt. of ECE to allow him to facing the Selection Committee.

With the permission of Chair, Director IIITA placed the agenda before the Hon'ble BoG.

Dr. Ashutosh Kumar Singh, was in the AGP of Rs. 7000 as a permanent faculty in contrast to Assistant Professor on contractual position as per 4- tier scheme. Recently, there were instances where NITs had allowed the Assistant Professors with AGPs 6000 and 7000 for Associate Professor's position. His 07 years of length of service as a permanent faculty in AGP 7000 with Ph.D may therefore be considered eligible and allow him to be considered for the Associate Professor.

The case of Dr. A.K Singh is presented here for deliberations.

Technical comments from MoE : *The matter may be deliberated and decision as per the provisions in the Four Tier Flexible Cadre may be taken after deliberations.*

Resolution : Hon'ble BoG has resolved that the case of Dr. Ashutosh Kumar Singh, Assistant Professor now in Level-12 should be governed as per 4- tier flexible cadre structure only.

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18.12 To consider and approve the Medical Expenditure incurred for Late Prof. Shirshu Varma in critical emergency.

With the permission of Chair, Secretary BoG placed the agenda before the Board.

Prof. Late Shirshu Varma was residing in Institute campus, suffered a major heart attack on 29.11.2020 and had to be emergently rushed & hospitalized in critical condition in the ICCU of the Institute empanelled Saraswati Heart Care Hospital in Allahabad where he was diagnosed as a case of Extensive anterior wall myocardial infarction. Prof. Shirshu Varma needed special kind of treatment that was not possible in normal hospital and required special assistance which was only available in hospitals like AIIMS/PGI/Medanta etc. It was pandemic time and Govt. Hospitals like AIIMS/PGI etc. did not have beds readily available for immediate admission. It was an extremely emergency condition. When his condition was deteriorating continuously the doctors of Saraswati Heart Care directed for an emergency shift of the patient to Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon, since it was not the time to wait for a chance at any Govt. Hospital. The condition of Prof. Varma was very critical and he was not in a position to travel such a long distance by road so he was transferred via air ambulance. He was admitted in ICU at Medanta and underwent life-saving medical procedures- coronary angioplasty, balloon stenting, CP Pump set, ventilator etc. continuously being monitored by a group of doctors headed by Dr. Praveen Chandra. However, Prof. Shirshu Varma could not sustain and recover, even after all life-saving efforts, he breathed his last on 03.12.2020.

The Hon'ble Board is requested to take a compassionate stand and allow the Institute to admit the medical expenses treating it as a very special case and as a onetime measure.

Therefore the Board is requested

- (i) to consider reimbursement and adjustment of a non-CGHS enlisted amount of Rs. 25,84,817/- "as per actuals" by IIIT-A, as per Ministry of Health Guideline (OM No. 2-1/2012/CGHS/VC/CGHS(P) dated: 01.08.2013, Para b & d) and
- (ii) to condone the recoverable amount of Rs. 83,654/- from the terminal benefit of terminal benefits of deceased employee (Leave Encashment etc.)

It was also presented before the house that the subject was urgently placed in the FC on 7.07.2021 as per the telephonic advice by the Ministry. Based on the urgency and the serious nature of the matter the agenda was consented for discussion in the FC.

Hon'ble Chairman kindly explained that the FC was empathetic, the FC observed pitiable status of the family and that the FC finally recommended its acceptance.

Technical comments from MoE : *As per the comments of Director(Finance), Member of FC of the Ministry.*

Resolution: Hon'ble BoG resolved to admit the expenditures on the treatment of Late Prof. Shirshu Verma as a very special case and as a onetime measure and ratified the recommendation of FC.

18.13 To be apprised of the Legal issues (Court Cases) of the Institute.

With the permission of Chair Secretary BoG has requested to Prof. Shekhar Verma who is looking after the Institute Legal Cell provided the status of legal cases of Institute. The Board was apprised about the status of legal issues (Court Cases) currently being dealt by the Institute in which most of them are infructuous in nature. Except one case of Shri Shreyank Singh who have gone to the court against the decision of Board.

Technical comments from MoE : May be noted.

Resolution: Hon'ble BoG has observed and noted the same.

18.14 Adaptation and Implementation of Group Medical Insurance Scheme for the Employees of the Institute through open tender.

Secretary BoG apprised that agenda was re-itemized and placed before the board to discuss the deliberations of 44th FC Meeting. It was further noted that the Ministry's had provided its comments and informed that similar proposal for all CFIs is already under consideration in the Ministry. Chairman BoG stated that specific recommendation as discussed in the 44th FC Meeting may also be communicated to the Ministry.

Technical comments from MoE : *May be deliberated in the meeting. Institute may be advised to collect some portion of premium from the employees as per Govt. rules like CGHS, CSMA. The practice being followed in other IIITs in this regard may also be looked into.*

Resolution of BoG: BoG resolved that the Institute would wait for the centralised scheme for all CFIs. Further, the suggestions made by FC in this regard will be sent to the Ministry for consideration.

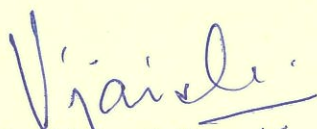
18.15 To apprise the Disciplinary Enquiry against the Sh. G.R Singh , AE (Civil) IWD.

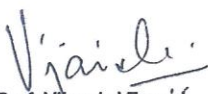
