The Chairman, Senate welcomed all the Members present in the meeting.

Prof Anupam, IIIT A, Prof. Ashish Dutta, IIT Kanpur; and Prof. Harish Karnick, IIT Kanpur could not attend the meeting owing to their preoccupation and were, therefore, granted the leave of absence.

Thereafter, the Agenda items were taken:

ITEM NO. 1: To decide the course of action on the issue of irregular admission during academic year 2004, 2005 & 2010 into B.Tech. program at IIIT Allahabad

The Chairman, Senate briefed the background of the case to the members of the committee, and requested Dr. Neetesh Purohit, Associate Dean (AAA) to brief about the discrepancy found in the admission. Dr. Neetesh Purohit explained to the senate that there were only two ways of admitting the students in the BTech. program i.e. through AIEEE and DASA categories. The

Chairman, Senate also requested Prof. O P Vyas, CVO of the Institute to make presentation on the issue. The CVO presented the case before the senate.

After due deliberation, the Senate unanimously decided the following:

1. The course of action should proceed legally.

2. Explanation should be asked from the Officer I/c, Faculty I/c and Staff who were involved in the process of the admission during the academic years 2004, 2005 & 2010 to understand the instruction/direction/order under which the said admission were made and if the explanation is not provided, it is to be understood that the concerned was aware of the faulty admission process.

3. The affected 10 students should be asked to produce the seat allotment letter/admission offer letter issued from centralized admission agency (CCB) within 10 days; failing which the follow up action could attract to consider the cancellation of admission and

subsequently, withdrawal of the degree certificate.
